HEADING AWAY?



HAVE YOU COMPLETED AN ABSENCE FROM RESIDENCE FORM?

As Christmas is just around the corner, many residents are planning their Christmas holiday getaways.

One important aspect of your planning should be to complete a Victoria Police Absence from Residence form.

Letting police know is a proactive way you can help keep your home and community safe.

This is even more important if you'll be away a long time.

When you register with police, you provide:

- Your contact information.
- Times and dates you'll be away.
- Who to contact while you're away.

Police stations have an *absence from residence* register. This information could be used to reach you or your emergency contact if there is an incident at your home or to perform patrols in the area. Due to the dynamic nature of calls for police services, Victoria Police cannot guarantee that police will attend your property during your absence from your home.

Be sure to notify police if returning earlier than planned.

REGISTER ONLINE

To register your *absence from residence* online, visit https://service.vic.gov.au/find-services/housing-and-property/register-your-absence-from-residence

You can also register at your local police station.

To do so, download and complete the absence from residence form found at: https://www.police.vic.gov.au/absence-residence

Take the completed form to your local police station to be noted in the station's register.

YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION IS SAFE WITH US

Our Safeguard database has been operational for almost a year now and it is time to follow our usual procedure to ensure that all the personal information that we hold is correct and current.

Accuracy of our information is vital when needed by **Emergency Services.**

You can expect a call from one of our volunteers in the new year asking you to confirm the details that we hold for you.

This project may take many weeks!

We have a large database and a limited number of volunteer staff.

Your details that may have changed since we last contacted you are:

- Landline disconnected

ARE YOUR CONTACT PEOPLE STILL THE SAME?

Our new system will allow us to add to the list. Family, friends and neighbours can be included - those who live nearest are best points of contact for the Police in emergency.

There is no need to take any action if all of your personal information remains the same.
